Did you know the book of Deuteronomy is among the top 5 books of the Bible in the number of time the word “Love” is used?

On the left, it's up there with Psalms, Proverbs, John and Song of Solomon.

On the right you can see the phrase “Bless you” is used most often in Deuteronomy. More than any other book in the Bible.

I noticed the word “Rejoice” frequently in our Parsha, so I looked that up and found that it's tied with Proverbs for the number of times it tells us to rejoice – 3rd most in the whole Bible.

And in the Torah, no other book uses these three words more.
